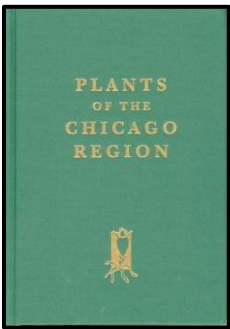

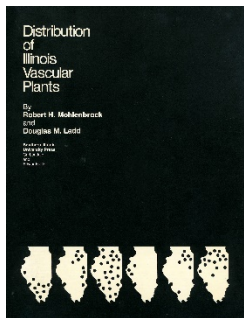

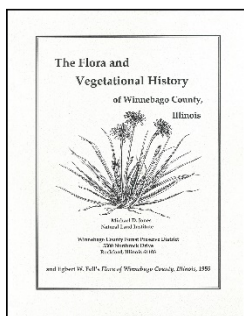

### **Distribution of Illinois Vascular Plants**

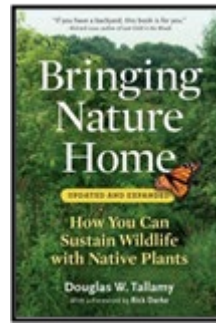

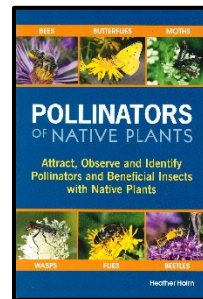


### **Bringing Nature Home**

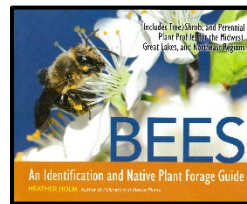

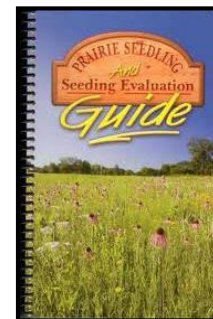

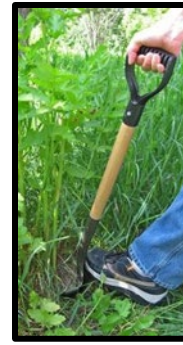
