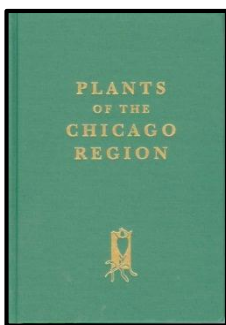

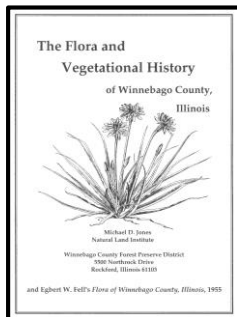

The definitive source for specific plant details, including plant communities and “coefficients of conservatism” ratings for each plant to determine a natural area assessment. **\$45.00**



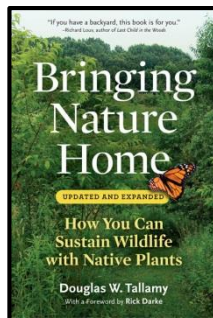
Distribution of Illinois Vascular Plants

Out of print, this is the only plant survey that includes every county in Illinois. Available in very limited quantities. **\$30.00**



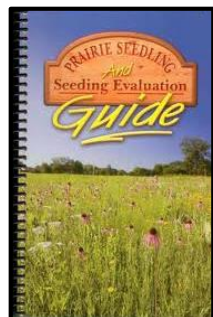
The Flora and Vegetational History of Winnebago County, Illinois by Michael D. Jones, Natural Land Institute.

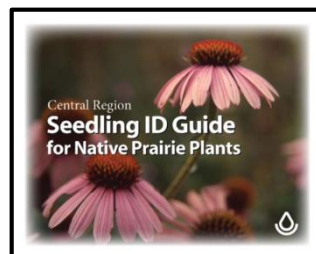
Bringing Nature Home
